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## **CYAID 2008 ALBERTA TOUR INFORMATION**

**(CYAID 2008 HOSTED BY TADD NEW BRUNSWICK AT UNB)**

SADD Alberta will be hosting a tour to CYAID 2008 in Fredericton, New Brunswick including additional days touring the Maritimes including Nova Scotia, PEI and New Brunswick.

We will be arriving in Halifax, Nova Scotia on Saturday, May 3 and flying out of Charlottetown, PEI on Sunday, May 11. We are flying home from Charlottetown rather than Fredericton as flights out of Charlottetown are consistently a better price.

We will be staying at the Holiday Inn Express in Halifax on Saturday, Sunday and Monday nights. Our days in Nova Scotia will be spent touring the Halifax area and some additional locations. This would tentatively include the Halifax Citadel, Pier 21, The Historic Properties, Maritime Museum of the Atlantic, Peggy's Cove, Lunenburg, etc.

On Tuesday we drive to Charlottetown, PEI where we will stay at the Super 8 Hotel in Charlottetown.

On Wednesday we will depart for Fredericton, NB and we will be staying on the beautiful campus at the University of New Brunswick (home to CYAID 2008) Wednesday night through to Sunday morning, at the completion of the CYAID Conference. At noon on Sunday we will take a bus to Charlottetown where we will fly back to Alberta.

**The cost for this tour is \$1,000 NOT INCLUDING AIRFARE.** Current airfare is approximately \$700.

The tour is limited to 49 people and will be filled on a first come basis. At this time, we have had inquiry from more than 49 so please register early to avoid disappointment. The \$1,000 tour fee is **all-inclusive**. All meals, accommodation, transportation costs, admittance to tour attractions and the delegate CYAID registration fee are included in this price. Delegates will require their own spending money.

**We require a \$700 deposit for each person that will be attending the tour as soon as possible.**

With your \$700 deposit, we will require the legal name of every students and adult attending - as it appears of government issued photo ID. Once we have received all of this information and your deposits, we will book the flights for your group.

We will be splitting our SADD Alberta group when flying, keeping schools together, which should help keep the cost of airfare down. We will do our very best to keep your entire group together. WE WILL CONTACT YOU PRIOR TO BOOKING IF WE ARE UNABLE TO PUT YOUR ENTIRE GROUP ON THE SAME FLIGHT.

**The balance owing will be due on April 3, 2008.**

**Tentative Tour and Bus Schedule**

**Saturday, May 3**

Pick up at Halifax Airport and shuttle to Holiday Inn Express Halifax/Bedford (2 or 3 trips – a school bus will do)

**Sunday, May 4**

Tour possibilities include the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic, Historic Properties, The Citadel. Pick up and drop at Holiday Inn Express – School Bus.

**Monday, May 5**

Tour possibilities include Pier 21, Peggy's Cove, Lunenburg. Pick up and drop at Holiday Inn Express – School Bus.

**Tuesday, May 6**

Drive to Charlottetown, PEI and tour along the way on a Highway Coach. Stay in Charlottetown overnight.

**Wednesday, May 7**

Tour Charlottetown and drive to Fredericton, New Brunswick in a Highway Coach. Stay in Fredericton at the University of New Brunswick (CYAID location).

**Thursday, May 8**

Morning tour of Fredericton.

**Thursday, May 8 to Sunday, May 11**

All delegates attend CYAID 2008 following their agenda.

**Sunday, May 11**

Delegates will fly out of Charlottetown, PEI and return home (better flight prices).
